



## **SIMON J DUDLEY LLB ACA CURRICULUM VITAE**

I am a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England & Wales, having qualified in 1992.

Prior to joining Forths Forensic Accountants, I was a Senior Manager in the Forensic Services department at Baker Tilly in Leeds, following the merger with HLB Kidsons in April 2002, and had been a Manager in the Forensic Services department at HLB Kidsons, in Leeds, having joined that firm in 1997.

Prior to joining HLB Kidsons, I was a Manager in the Forensic Services department at Haines Watts, having joined that firm in 1994. I have, therefore, worked in Forensic Accountancy, on a full time basis for over 10 years.

I have undertaken forensic accounting / litigation support work both pre and post issue, assisting both Claimant and Defendant solicitors, insurance companies and barristers to advise upon and quantify the value of claims.

I specialise in, and have extensive experience of:

- Personal Injury work (loss of earnings, loss of profits, CICA)
- Fatal Accident dependency claims
- Pension Losses (final salary and money purchase schemes)
- Military claims
- Business Interruption claims

I am currently involved in over 200 cases per year, including Single Joint instructions. Approximately 60% of my instructions are received on behalf of the Claimant and 40% on behalf of the Defendant.

My involvement in these cases is typically to obtain discovery of documents, analyse these and to prepare a report to assist the Court. I attend Conferences with Counsel, prepare Joint Statements and give evidence in Court if required.

Before specialising in Forensic Accountancy I trained with KPMG, working in a mainline Audit department and undertook periods of secondment to the Insolvency and Small Business departments.
